Reverse fold to the tail so that the two points touch.






Fold the bottom point up while closing the flap.




Mountain fold the tail flap inside (almost a kite fold, but not all of the way). Repeat behind.




Inside reverse fold the head. The bottom part of the crease is roughly made at the half way point between the tip and the chest.




Outside reverse fold the head (the beak will become parallel to the neck




Inside reverse fold the beak, but keep the point outside of the neck. If you can, make the beakparallel to duck's back (top of model).
