How to present, describe, analyse and comment upon a visual document

I-identify =

- type of document
- source
- date
- topic or subject
- target and/or global goal or aim

D-escribe =

- divide into parts
- locate the different elements
- talk about shape and colour
- ...

A-nalyse = what message(s)?

H-idden context =

- relate the document to a more general subject

O-pinion =

- efficient or not and why? /
- like or dislike and why?

METHODOLOGY

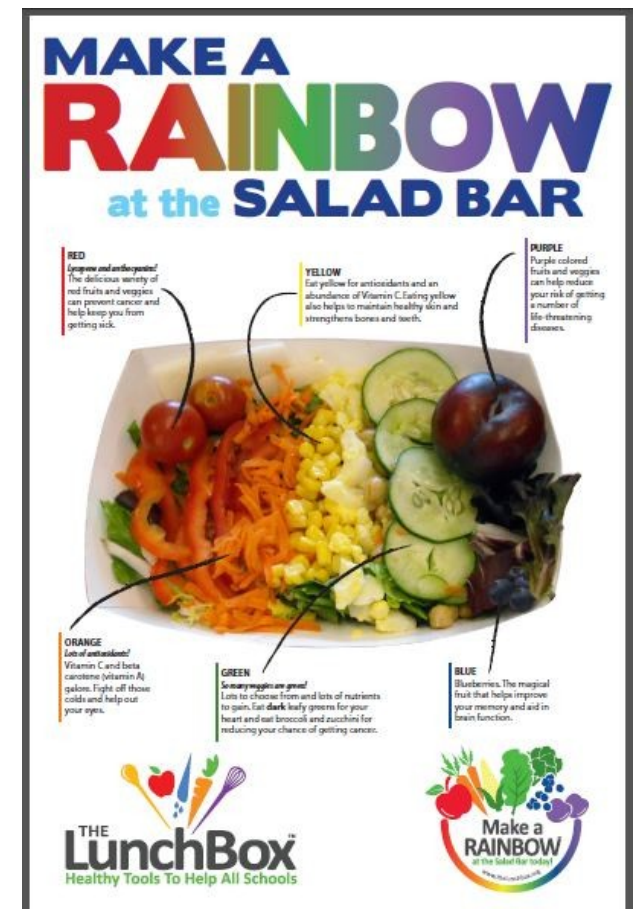
