## Speech of Dominique BAERT Member of Parliament- Mayor of Wattrelos

We, who in the North of France have a reputation -and tradition- of knowing how to welcome and receive generously, we just feel like home here.

And if sometimes we speak with our hands, we talk mostly with our eyes, and always with the heart. It's obvious: we are members of the same community!

English and German friends, you can be thanked, you can be proud above all. So we are in front of the strength of your relationships, and your strong ties.

Now we are no longer strangers to each other. We have grown together with Eschweiler for so many years, that our citizens are now part of the same family. Regarding Reigate & Bandstead, we have enjoyed seeing each other for a while, since 2004 precisely. First, thanks to the Twinning association, which attracted considerable attention during our Carnival. Let me thank Penelope, Janet and Graham!

But I also remember that in 2009, the musical group The Redhill Corps of Drums and Band put up a much appreciated performance during that carnival. Thanks to them, we set our relationship to music!

The current events on Wattrelos side, are now the school exchanges. Thus in October 2008 a project emerge between our private school L'Enfant Jésus and the elementary school Saint John's of Redhill. A meeting between teachers and directors was held in July 2009, followed by another one in November. Thus a year ago.

And what do you think happened? Of course: an exchange of students, the first French-English of the history o of Wattrelos, from 29 to 31 March, in Reigate and Banstead – and in the other side, it will take place in Wattrelos next week.
