18th International Festival of Chess, Bridge and Games

Pardubice 12th - 29th July 2007, Czech Republic

Small modification possible

3rd World School Chess Teams Championship 12.-18.7. 2007

- tournaments of schools in categories up to 10, 12, 14 and 16 years of age (4-member teams)
- a tournament of clubs (4-member teams with 1 player up to 10, 12, 14, and 16 years of age)
- 7 rounds by Swiss system
- 1,5h / 40 moves + 30 min + 30s / each move from the first move

4th European Amateurs Chess Championship 18.-29.7. 2007

- tournaments in categories men and women with ELO FIDE < 2200, ELO FIDE < 2000 and ELO < 1800
- tournaments in active chess in above mentioned categories

Chess tournaments:

A) 20.-29.7. Open grand master tournament - GM and IM norms, rating for ACP TOUR and FIDE
- ELO FIDE \geq 2200, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 2h + 30s/move

B1) 20.-29.7. Open rating tournament -rating for FIDE
- ELO FIDE > 1800, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 2h + 30s/move

B2) 21.-29.7. Open European Amateurs Championship with ELO FIDE < 2200 - rating for FIDE
- ELO FIDE < 2200 or ELO nat. >1800, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2h/40 + 1h

C) 21.-29.7. Open European Amateurs Championship with ELO FIDE < 2000 - rating for FIDE
- ELO FIDE < 2000 or ELO national > 1600, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2h/40 + 1h

D) 21.-29.7. Open European Amateurs Championship with ELO < 1800
- ELO FIDE < 1800 or ELO national < 1800, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2h/40 + 1h

E) 12.-15.7. Open Championship of the Czech Republic of 4-member team tournament - rating for FIDE
- without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 1,5h + 30s/move

F) 20.7. Open 4-member team tournament of youngsters up to 16 years of age in active chess
- players born in 1991 and younger, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 20 min.

G1) 18.-19.7. Open Championship of the Czech Republic in active chess - rating for ACP TOUR
- without limitations, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 30 min.

G2) 18.-19.7. European Amateurs Championship with ELO FIDE < 2200 in active chess
- players from ECU countries with ELO FIDE < 2200 or without ELO FIDE, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 30 min.

G3) 18.-19.7. European Amateurs Championship with ELO FIDE < 2000 in active chess

- players from ECU countries with ELO FIDE < 2000 or without ELO FIDE, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 30 min.

G4) 18.-19.7. European Amateurs Championship with ELO < 1800 in active chess

- players from ECU countries with ELO FIDE < 1800 or with ELO nat. < 1800, 9 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 30 min.

H) 16.-17.7. Open Championship of the Czech Republic in blitz marathon

- without limitations, each with each (max. 24 hours), 2 x 5 min.

I) 22.7. Open blitz k.o. tournament

- without limitations, 9 rounds by Swiss system + k. o., 2 x 5 min.

J) 13.-19.7. Open rating tournament with rating for FIDE

- without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 1,5h + 30s/move

K) 14.-15.7. European Problem Solving Championship

- without limitations, solving system according to rules of the world solving championship

L) 16.7. Open Championship of the Czech Republic of bughouse

- pairs of players without limitations, 9 double rounds by Swiss system 2 x 3 min. + 3 s / move (Bronstein system) + finals group 2 x 1 min. + 3 s / move (Bronstein system)

M) 17.7. Open Championship of the Czech Republic of Fischerandom chess - Vladimir Novak` s memorial tournament

- without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 30 min.

N) 18.7. Open super blitz chess tournament

- without limitations, 9 double rounds by Swiss system + finals group, 2 x 3 min.

O) 16.7. Open pairs tournament in active chess

- pairs of players without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 15 min.

P) 17.7. Open pairs blitz tournament

- pairs of players without limitations, 7 rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 5 min.

Q) 24.7.-26.7. Open blitz tournaments series - 3 separate tournaments

- without limitations, 7 double rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 5 min.

R) 27.7. Open 4-member teams blitz tournament

- without limitations, 7 double rounds by Swiss system, 2 x 5 min.

Tournaments in bridge, scrabble, Czech marriage, go, draughts, shogi, backgammon, RPG games, renju and gomoku, ZATRE, othello, mills and other games will take place within the frame of the festival. 4 562 starts of players from 47 countries were registered in 2006.
