

## St-Guénolé Shawl

 Silk and Wool - July 2012 http://www.helenespat.com/This model is easy to knit, with simple construction.

## Stitch Abbreviations:

K - Knit
P-Purl
YO - Yarn over
K2tog - Knit 2 together Make1 - lifted increase Kfb - Knit into the front and back of a stitch


Why is the pattern called "St-Guenole"?
Because it has been knitted especially on a bench facing the sea to St-Guenole, a fishing port of Brittany. Not forgetting, of course, the cry of the gulls ... perhaps also because it has a "fishing net " aspect.

## Materials:

Yarn: BC Garn Lino in natural color (300m/ 100g per ball, need 1.5 balls) - This is fingering weight yarn.
Needles: 4.5 mm , US size 7
( 3 balls of Kidopale de Fonty is another yarn recommendation)

Note from Purly-Penguin: My French skills are non-existent. I found a reference guide of knitting terms in several languages and used that to muddle my way through this pattern. While the math appears to work through this pattern, it has not bee tested. If anyone finds items that need to be changed, please let me know through Ravelry messages.

Cast on 3 sts
Row 1: K1, YO, K1, YO, K1
Even Rows 2-10: Knit all sitches, twisting the YOs to avoid large holes.
Row 3: K1, YO, K1, YO, K2, YO, K: (8 sts)
Row 5: K1, YO, K2, YO. K2, YO, K2, YO, K1 (12 sts)
Row 7: K1, [YO, K2]x5, YO, K1 (18 sts)
Row 9: K1, [YO, K2]x8, YO, K1 (27 sts)
Row 11: K3, [YO, K3]x8 (35 sts)
Even Rows 12-20: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4
Odd Rows: 13-19: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 21: K3, YO, K1, [K2tog]x18, YO, K3
Row 22: K4, [K1, Make1]x18, K5
Row 23: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 24: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4
Row 25: K3, YO, K1, [K2tog] to the end of row, YO, K3
Row 26: K4, [ K1, Make1] to the end of row, K5
Row 27: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 28: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4: (51 sts)
Row 29: K3, [YO, K3] to the end of row
Row 30: Knit all: (67 sts)
Odd Rows 31-49: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Even Rows 32-48: Knit all
Row 50: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4: (87 sts)
Row 51: K3, [YO, K3] to the end of row
Row 52: Knit all: (115 sts)
Row 53: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 54: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4


Row 55: K3, YO, K1, Work in Bamboo Stitch to last 3 sts,
YO, K3

## BAMBOO STITCH

= [YO - K2 - lift the YO loop up over the two knitted stitches]
Even Rows 56-62: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4
Row 57: K3, YO, K2, Work in Bamboo Stitch to last 4 sts, K1, YO, K3
Row 59: repeat 55
Row 61: repeat 57
Row 63: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 64: Knit all: (127 sts)
Row 65: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 66: Knit all
Row 67: Kfb, [ YO, K1 ] until the last st, Kfb
Row 68: Knit all, dropping all YOs
Row 69: Kfb, [YO, K1] to the end of row, Kfb

Row 70: Knit all, dropping all YOs
Rows 71.73.75.77: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Rows 72.74.76.78: Purl all
Row 79: K3, [ YO, K3] to the end of row
Row 80: Knit all: 187 sts
Row 81: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Rows 82: Knit all

## Mesh Section:

Rows 83, 87, 91, 95, 99, 103: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Rows 84, 88, 92, 96, 100, 104: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4
Rows 85, 89, 93, 97, 101, 105: K3, YO, K1, [K2tog] to the end of row, YO, K3
Rows 86, 90, 94, 98, 102, 106: K4, [K1, Make1] to the end of row, K5
Row 107: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 108: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4: (215 sts)
Row 109: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 110: K4, Purl all till 4 sts remain, K4
Row 111: K3, [YO, K3] to the end of row
Row 112: Knit all: (287 sts)
Rows 113-118: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
Row 119: Kfb, [YO, K1] to the end of row, Kfb
Row 120: Knit all, dropping all YOs
Rows 121-124: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3 Row 125: Kfb, [YO, K1] to the end of row, Kfb
Row 126: Knit all, dropping all YOs
Rows 127-134: K3, YO, Knit all till 3 sts remain, YO, K3
 Row 135: Kfb entire row

Row 136: IN CROCHET: Chain 1 along edge, *chain 3 in the air, chain 1 along the edge by jumping a stitch* (note from Purly-Penguin, I'm not very good at crocheted edges, but I think the increase in row 135 will lend it self well to casting off in a regular knitting way. Otherwise, this crochet row is the last row)
