

TUTORIAL FINISHING A BOOKMARK

What you need:

Your stitching

Fine felt (not too soft though)

Ruler, scissors, pen

Thread (color matching the felt)

A homemade tassel

Pins

A sewing needle and a wool needle

Flat iron



On the back of the linen, draw lines all around the stitching and cut, leaving 1cm.

Fold the linen towards the back following the lines and press with the iron (put the stitching on a terry towel to avoid flattening the stitches).

To make the point, fold the base first, then the sides.



Cut a piece of felt slightly smaller (1mm less) than the stitching, and pin it to the back.



Sew the felt to the linen with an invisible stitch, taking care to prick the needle in the folds only.



At the top center, form a small hole with a wool needle, then slip the tassel's hooking threads from the back to the front of the bookmark.



Make a knot and slip the tassel into the loop thus formed.



With a needle, slip the threads in the felt on the back of the bookmark to have a nice looking back.



You can now add a small charm...



And there it is! Congrats!



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
