As we told you in the last newsletter, the Boundou CNR is really there, on the ground. The proof, the first boundary post of the CNR was placed on 7 April at Koussan. Soon, the 120 000 ha of the reserve will be visible by all, 120 000 ha of a community protected area, regulated by a local code and kept watch by 32 eco-guards. If a long way still remains to get this surveillance effective, we are still moving in the right direction. Let's continue like that !

However, we would like to inform you about the loss of one of us last month, Samba Cissokho of Sansanding, President of the vigilance committee of the Toumboura area. We present our deepest sympathy to his family, which has lost a man aware of the need to preserve the CNR, but also a highly valued rural adviser.

Finally as Président du Conseil rural de Dougué, I repeat my support to the Boundou and I encourage the populations to get involve to the maximum for the success of our project. We have to get up, to work, and to show every one that the CNR is a reality !

Within the project of guinea-fowl farming and Limousin rooster breeding in the CNR, supported by the PNR of Millevaches of Limousin, a support fund for Income Generating Activities (IGA) has been created.

This funds will enable candidate farmers to get micro-credit in order to start their farming activity : buy hens, guinea-fowls and small equipment (the project already guarantees the training course and a part of the materials for the hen house). The money lent will be paid off from the sale of products and will be available for other farmers, or even other development activities in the CNR.



To date, 335 000 Fcfa (that is 510 €) has been collected, by donations from the private individuals and voluntary organisations, to support the activities of development of the Boundou CNR. ## Training course of the guinea-fowls farmers

From 8 to 12 March 2011, the candidates for guinea-fowls farming met for a training course and the building of the 1<sup>st</sup> demonstration hen house.

Logically, this first training course has been spent in the village of Didé Gassama, head office of the trade union "Bamtaare Sisse ni Kamo". On the syllabus, all on guinea-fowl farming : housing, feeding, breeding, care and vaccination... With 18 motivated volunteers, including the president of the trade union Amadou DIALLO ("Diappa").

The 1<sup>st</sup> demonstration hen house was built at the home of Mamadou Fofana, an experienced and volunteer farmer, promoting the use of local and environmentally sensitive materials (clay, straw...).



Back home, the farmers will have to build their own hen house to receive their 3 first breeding guinea-fowls ...

> The participants : farmers from Belly, Linguekone, Koussan, Didé, Bancouba, Toumboura, Sansanding, Gonguedji and Ndiarendi.
