# Welcome

Described by MURRAY WALKER OBE as the 'greatest motor-sporting event in the world', the Isle of Man TT is a truly unique and awesome spectacle that has no equal and no substitute. Excitement, glory, disappointment and despair - the TT has it all. If you are a fan of motorcycle sport in its purest form, the Isle of Man is the only place to be in 2015. If you haven't been before you are in for the ride of your life!



## Racers prepare for the 'perfect lap'

The Isle of Man TT Races is truly one of the world's greatest spectator sports. Trackside fans have witnessed spectacular achievements and historical milestones from stunning vantage points around the iconic 37% miles of public roads for over one hundred years. Titles have been won and lost in dramatic fashion over the decades against a backdrop of landmark shattering memories as riders have added their own names and stories to the growing list of legendary road races.

This year is set to be no exception with the most competitive grid in living memory - 13 of the 14 fastest men ever to grace the Mountain Course are set to line up on Glencrutchery Road in 2015. It's not just Bruce Anstey's outright lap record that the field will be chasing as there's only six seconds protecting the first sub 17 minute lap and the chance to join some of the greatest names in the sport's history.

Multiple champions John McGuinness, Michael Dunlop and Bruce Anstey will be looking over their shoulders as a growing pack of emerging talent, led by Josh Brookes and Peter Hickman, look to dethrone the established kings of the Mountain Course. Gary Johnson, Dean Harrison and James Hillier have all tasted victory in recent years and will be looking to add to their titles while Guy Martin, Conor Cummins and Lee Johnston will all be desperate to stand on the top step for the first time.

In the sidecars, honours have been shared in recent years and this year's races will see 7 TT winners on the start-line headed by multiple champion Dave Molyneux as he looks to add to his 17 TT wins.

After a week of qualifying from Saturday 30th May, the race programme gets underway on Saturday 6th June with the Superbike and Sure Sidecar Race 1. Monday 8th June features the double header of Monster Energy Supersport and RL360 Superstock races while Wednesday 10th June's packed programme includes the second Monster Energy Supersport and Sure Sidecar races and the groundbreaking TT Zero.

The Bike Nation Lightweight TT, which opens the final day's race programme on Friday 12th June, is a great way to whet the appetite before the meeting climaxes with the blue ribbon PokerStars Senior TT.

# MANX GRAND PRIX [www.manxgrandprix.org](http://www.manxgrandprix.org)

The idea of a race for young motorcycling amateurs and private entrants on the world famous TT Course was first mooted in the early twenties. The first Manx Amateur Road Race Championship was held in 1923, the meeting later to be known as the Manx Grand Prix. Having celebrated its ninetieth anniversary in 2013, 'The Manx' is possibly the world's biggest race for amateurs and provides riders at grass roots level with the ultimate racing challenge.

Now an integral part of the Isle of Man Festival of Motorcycling, the Manx Grand Prix offers five races for 'modern' machines.

The racing is spectacular - typical of all racing on the famous TT Course, and its knowledgeable fans delight in spotting the next up-and-coming TT star. Indeed, the illustrious list of former Manx Grand Prix winners includes Michael Dunlop, Ian Hutchinson, Charlie Williams, Phil Read, Phillip McCallen, Nick Jefferies and Carl Fogarty.

Practice and qualifying commences on Saturday 22nd August and continues through the following week.

The opening race will be for Newcomers to be followed by the Junior Manx Grand Prix for 600cc machines, Supertwins, and Lightweight Manx Grand Prix races, culminating with the 'blue riband' 750cc Senior Manx Grand Prix on Friday 4th September.

The Manx National Two Day Trial has been won over the years by some of the leading names of British Trials; Artie Radcliffe, Sammy Miller, Martin Lampkin, Dougie Lampkin, Graham Jarvis and local star Steve Colley to name just a few. # ORANGE ARMY

### Who can Marshal?

Anyone aged over 16 who is reasonably fit and able to join us. (Parents or Guardian consent is required for those aged 16-18).

### Do I need to be experienced?

The TTMA runs several Incident Management Courses each year, both on and off the Island. This one day course covers the powers and duties of a marshal, safely managing and dealing with an incident, basic first aid, Air-Med Helicopter procedure, the use of race flags and operation of the TETRA radio.

Refresher courses are also held during the events together with a familiarisation session for new marshals. The Incident Management Course is free to all marshals.

If you only have the minimum experience required, you will be located with others who have more.

### Do I need to live on the Isle of Man?

Not at all; anyone is more than welcome. In fact over half our volunteers are not Island residents.

### Can I move to different locations each day?

Yes, but you will be encouraged to know about a particular area of the TT Course. You will gain intimate knowledge of these areas, something the normal fans don't get. If you wish to move, please tell us in advance.

### Do I have to attend all races and practices?

No you don't. If you can attend all the sessions it will be greatly appreciated, but any attendance at practice or race sessions is certainly welcome.
