About our School...

The **Lycée International de Los Angeles (LILA)** - also known as **The French American Schools of Southern California** - offers programs beginning with pre-school and leading to an American high school diploma and a French *Baccalauréat* or an International Baccalaureate diploma.

Live an international summer in Los Feliz!

The summer school program runs for 6 weeks: from Monday, June 21 to Friday, July 30 2010 serving ages 4 - 11 years old. The morning focuses on language acquisition through verbal, written and reading exercises. The afternoon is all about fun (still with an immersion in the language!). If you are currently at LILA or a French native on vacation in Los Angeles you can choose the "All day activities" camp. The camp facility is licensed by The State of California as a daycare center. Previous exposure to the French language is not required; we offer a fun and valuable experience to all children!

3 different camps designed for the needs of everyone

"Petits soleils" camp (3 to 4 years old)

Designed for children entering pre-k or getting ready for the upper grade. The mornings will focus on the acquisition of the French language. Games, arts and crafts, cooking, songs and reading will keep them busy in the afternoon in a fun way. The program will help the little ones gain social skills.

"Matins de France" camp (5 to 10 years old)

Planned to teach the fundamentals of the French language or maintain the knowledge of French, our accredited French teachers will lead the classes 3 times a week for two periods of 80 minutes. The children enrolled in French classes will join the other campers in our afternoon activities.

The objective of this program is to introduce children to the French language and culture at an early age when they still have a linguistic openness to easily learn a second language. Their adaptability, their lack of inhibition and, above all, their ability to reproduce any sound accurately will help them learn a second language with great ease. The course is designed to be challenging and fun at the same time. This program encourages the children to work together and progress at their own pace using a structured curriculum with workbooks and other fun activities.

The curriculum promotes the development of speaking, listening, reading and writing skills. In order to achieve fluency, various activities are undertaken in spelling, dictation and pronunciation as well as short writing tasks. The classes are designed for both beginning and intermediate speaking abilities.

The "Sports et loisirs" camp (5 to 10 years old)

Ideal for those who want a full day of activities by using physical activities and creativity to engage campers in their own learning. The day will be filled with sessions of Science, Art, Music, Choir, Tae Kwon Do, Yoga, Computer, Table Tennis, Basketball, Gymnastics, Hip Hop...

Our Staff

Our summer school is exclusively run and operated by dedicated and caring LILA teachers, coaches, and instructors. They are all experienced professionals (running different programs during the school year) and have first aid and CPR certificates. This is a French immersion program. However, everyone on the premises speaks English, so your little one will not be lost! Personnel references are available upon request.

Field trips

At "l'Ecole du Soleil" we believe that summer time is a great time to travel the city. Either beach days on Mondays or field trips on Wednesdays, campers will discover L.A.'s fun places and develop their social skills.

Backpack, cold lunch, sunscreen and towels (beach days) are mandatory for these days. Our ratio for chaperones is 1 adult for 8 campers and 1 adult for 5 little campers. We will use the Yellow school buses for transportation. Campers will receive a complimentary t-shirt for field trips. Based on the enrollments, we will announce the Wednesday field trips a week before.
